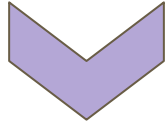

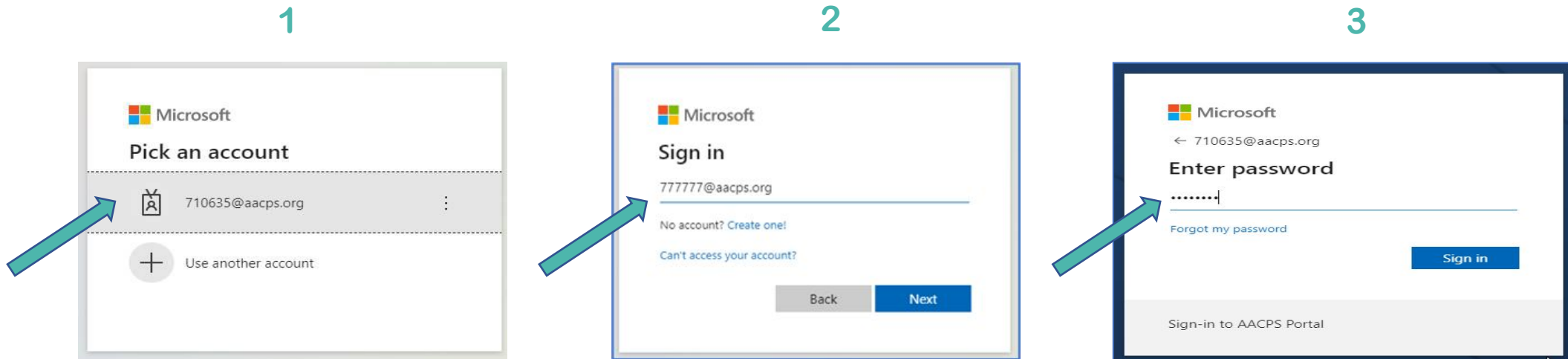

Step 1: Navigate to the Classlink Launchpad screen and Sign in with Microsoft.



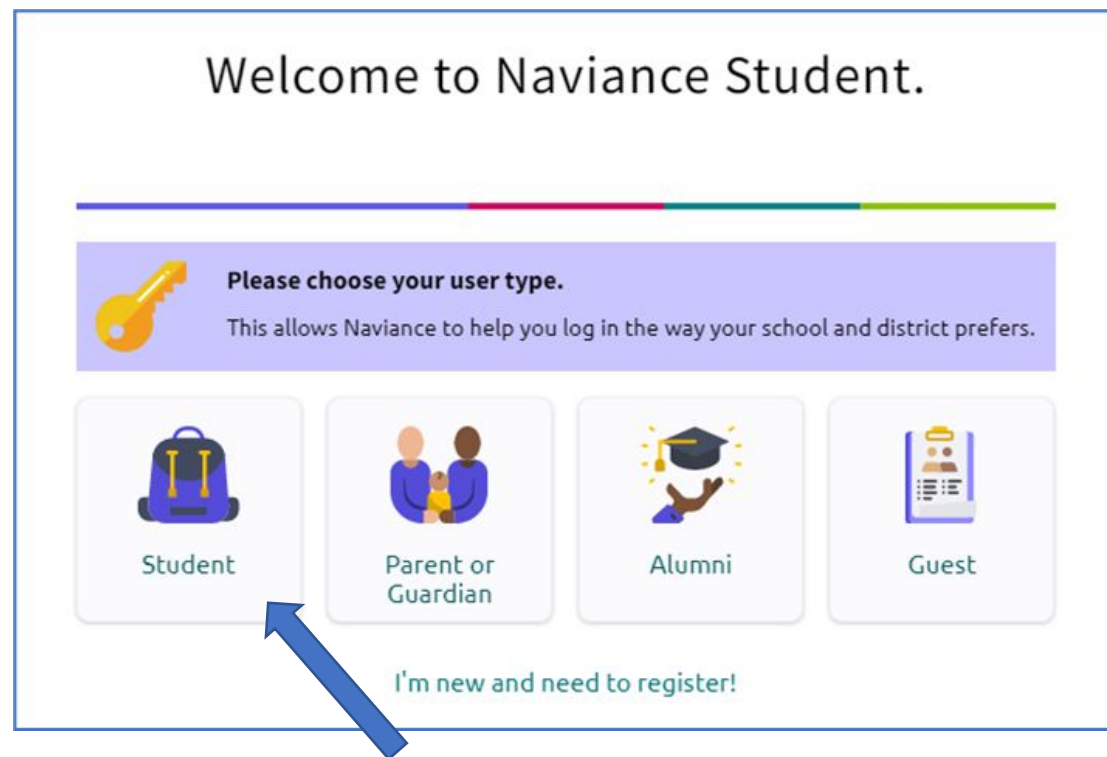
Step 2: Sign in to Microsoft using AACPS email and password.

Primary [+ Add Secondary Path](#)

- ☐ **College: Associate's Degree**
Earn an associate's degree or certificate in two years or less by attending a two-year community college or junior college.
- ☐ **College: Bachelor's Degree**
Earn a Bachelor's degree in four years by attending a four-year private or public college or university.
- ☐ **Career Education or Trade School**
Enroll in a short-term training program at a career or vocational-technical college and earn a certificate or associate's degree for an industry such as health care, cosmetology, and plumbing.
- ☐ **Apprenticeship Program**
Enroll in an apprenticeship to get on-the-job training with classroom instruction and mentorship that leads to a skilled trade or profession.
- ☐ **Military Service**
Enlist in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces right after high school or join after college by enrolling in a Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) program.
- ☐ **Employment**
Enter the job force right after high school to develop work skills and learn on the job without any formal training or education.
