

Step 1: Navigate to the Classlink Launchpad screen and Sign in with Microsoft.




Step 2: Sign in to Microsoft using AACPS email and password.




Step 3: Click the Naviance Icon on the Classlink page




Step 4: Click the Student Icon on Naviance Student page

Step 6: Click "select path".




Step 7: Click your icon.
