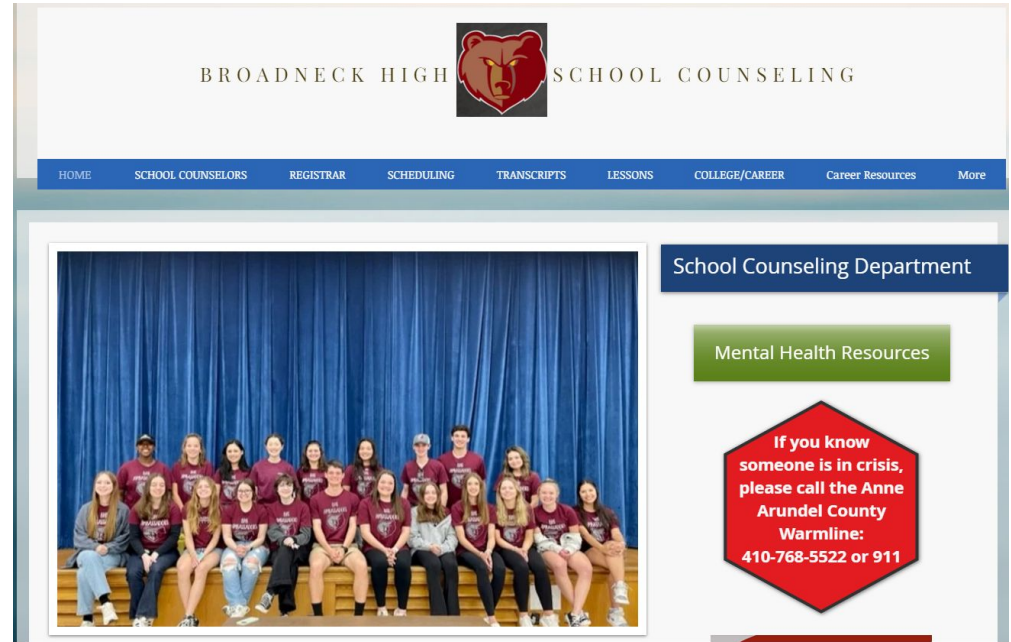

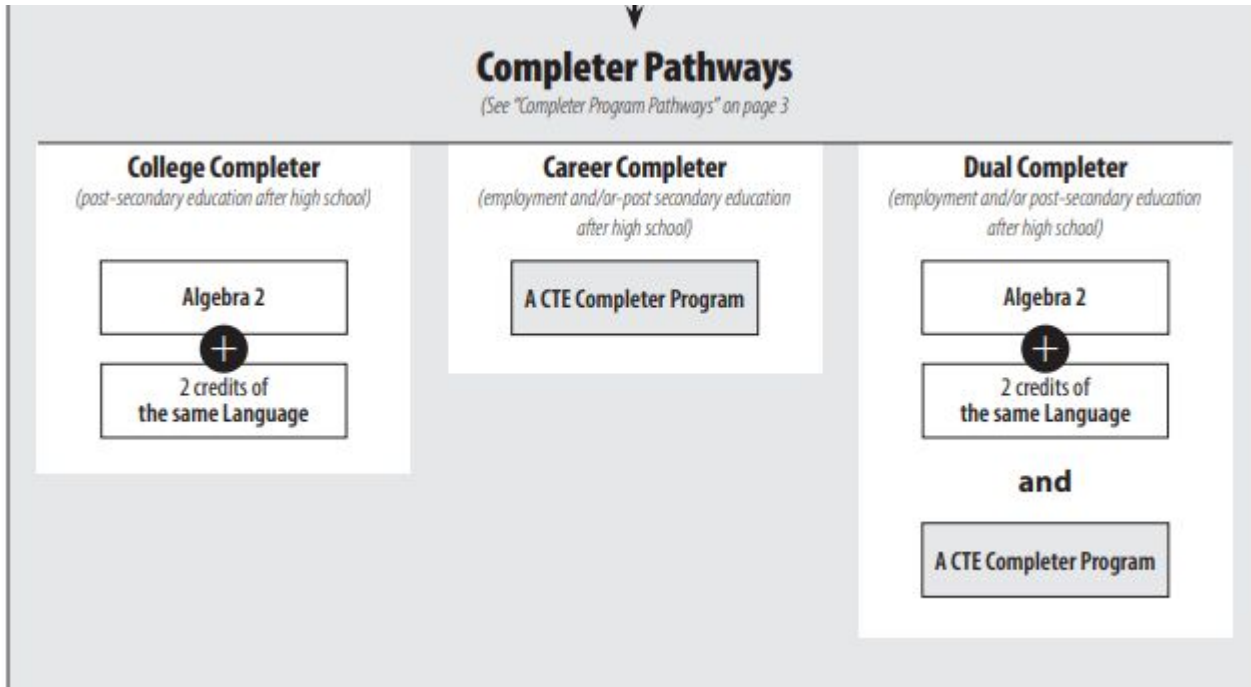

# Broadneck High School's Signature Program

Think of Environmental Literacy as our school's theme, and the Signature Program as an organization that provides students with unique opportunities that align with that theme. Field trips, guest speakers, school gardens, the greenhouse, BRUINS recycling, Eco-Action Club, internships, mentorships, service-learning, and college courses are a few examples of opportunities the Signature Program provides.



# Courses

Some Signature opportunities are made available to everyone in the school, such as gardening club, Earth Week celebrations and our Earth Day hiking field trip, the 9th grade field day at the Chesapeake Bay Foundation, and internships.

The students who have access to the MOST Signature opportunities, including monthly field trips, are the ones who take Signature Program courses. The courses offered through the Signature Program at BHS are:

- Environmental Literacy 1
- Environmental Literacy 2
- AACC Spring Cohort (Restoration Ecology & Intro to Drone Technology)

Anyone can sign up for these courses, and you register for them during regular course registration in the spring each year.

# Signature CTE Completer Pathway

Taking one or two Signature classes does not make you a CTE completer, or mean that you're required to take all of the Signature classes. The nice thing about the Signature Program is you can take advantage of what you want, and pass on the rest.

Those students who want to do it all, can earn a CTE certificate in Natural Resources and Conservation. This completer program can serve as your main path to graduation, or it can make you a dual completer.

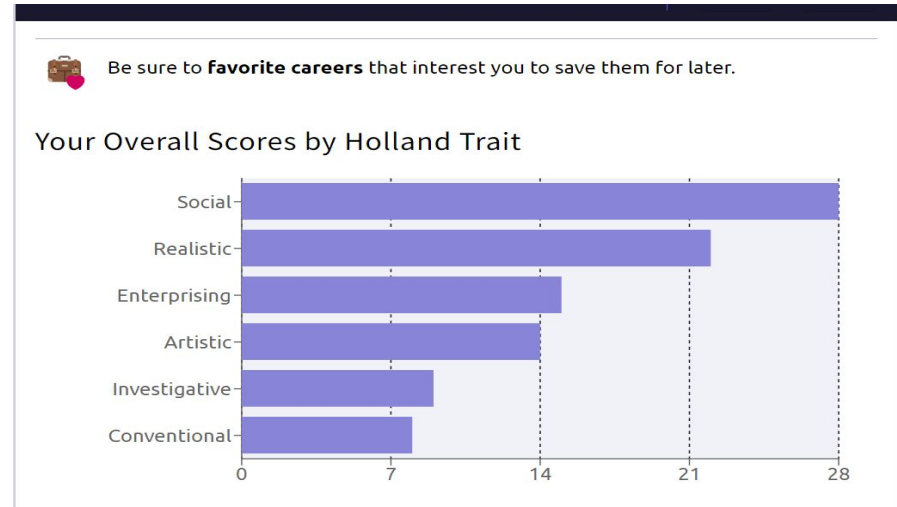

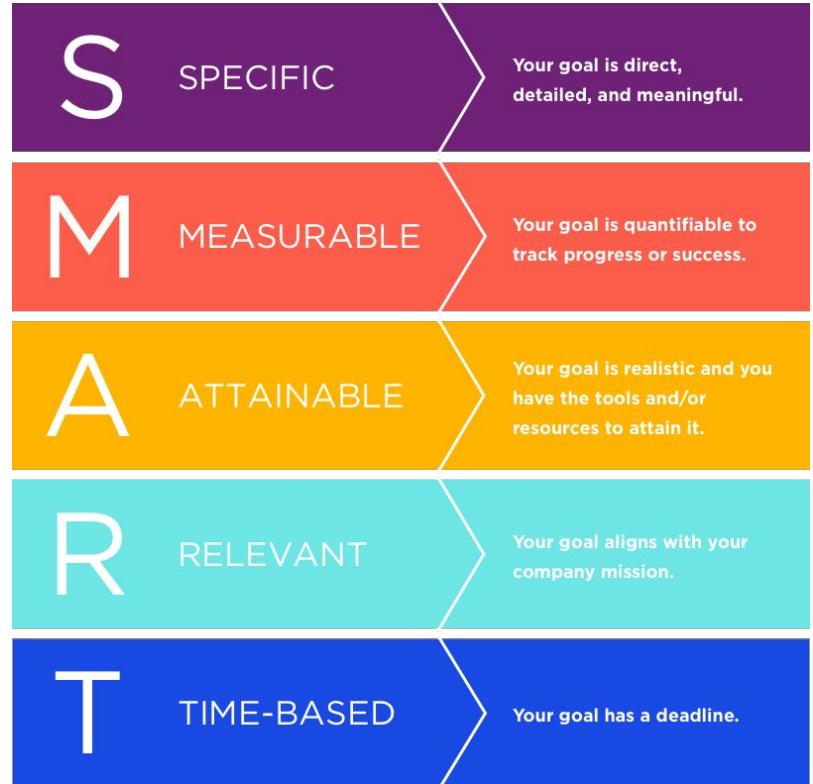


