

EARLY COLLEGE ACCESS (ECAP)



AACPS and Anne Arundel Community College (AACC) are joint sponsors of the Early College Access Programs (ECAP), which includes both Dual Credit and Non-Dual Credit programs. **ECAP** is designed to allow high school students to explore college level coursework in a variety of academic areas.

This college level coursework can complete the academic day for approved high school students who are progressing toward high school graduation and/or provide the opportunity to study college and careerrelated subject matter not otherwise available

through the traditional AACPS high school curriculum. Contact your high school counselor for more information.

AACC Visiting BHS: Dec. 13! Sign up in Naviance

- Take classes at AACC for ½ the cost & earn college credit
 - Seniors who want to transfer credit to a four-year university
 - Seniors who know they want to attend AACC to get started
- ECAP classes must be scheduled around the school schedule (BHS classes = priority)
- Placement is based on transcript, SAT/ACT, or ACCUPLACER
