Did you know eligible AACPS students can take classes at AACC tuition free?

SAVE TIME AND MONEY BY ATTENDING AACC.

The Early College Access Program (ECAP) offers eligible AACPS students the opportunity to take classes at AACC without paying tuition and fees. Simply submit an AACPS ECAP form approved by your school. High school juniors and seniors 16 and older with a 2.0 grade point average or higher are urged to apply and enroll!

To be an AACC student, you must first [apply](#) and then activate your MyAACC account. If you have any difficulties, call our Technical Help Desk at 410-777-HELP (4357).

Early College Access Program (ECAP)

Checklist:

- Go to aacps.org/ecap to view the ECAP Application form.
- Provide your AACPS username and password and the form will populate with your student information. If you need help accessing the form, email AACPS at help-desk@aacps.org.
- Print and complete the ECAP Application. The student, parent and high school representative must sign the form.
- Send the completed ECAP Application to AACC's cashier's office. Eligible AACPS students who submit an ECAP form approved by their school will not pay tuition or fees. Be sure to white out/scratch off your birth year, leaving only the day and month visible. For information email cashiersoffice@aacc.edu.
- What courses can I take? You must determine your placement with qualifying SAT, ACT or AP scores and may not need to take the Accuplacer. Additionally, high school seniors may submit their transcripts with their unweighted cumulative grade point average to determine placement. Send this information to the records office at records@aacc.edu. All high school students can email AACC's testing office at testing-arnold@aacc.edu for information on placement tests.
