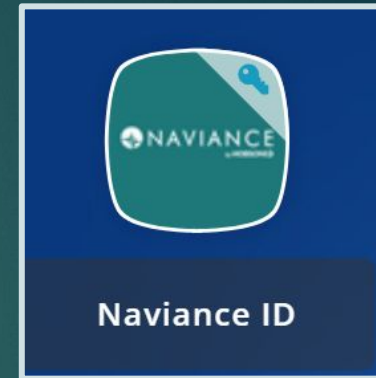



What about MONDAY?!

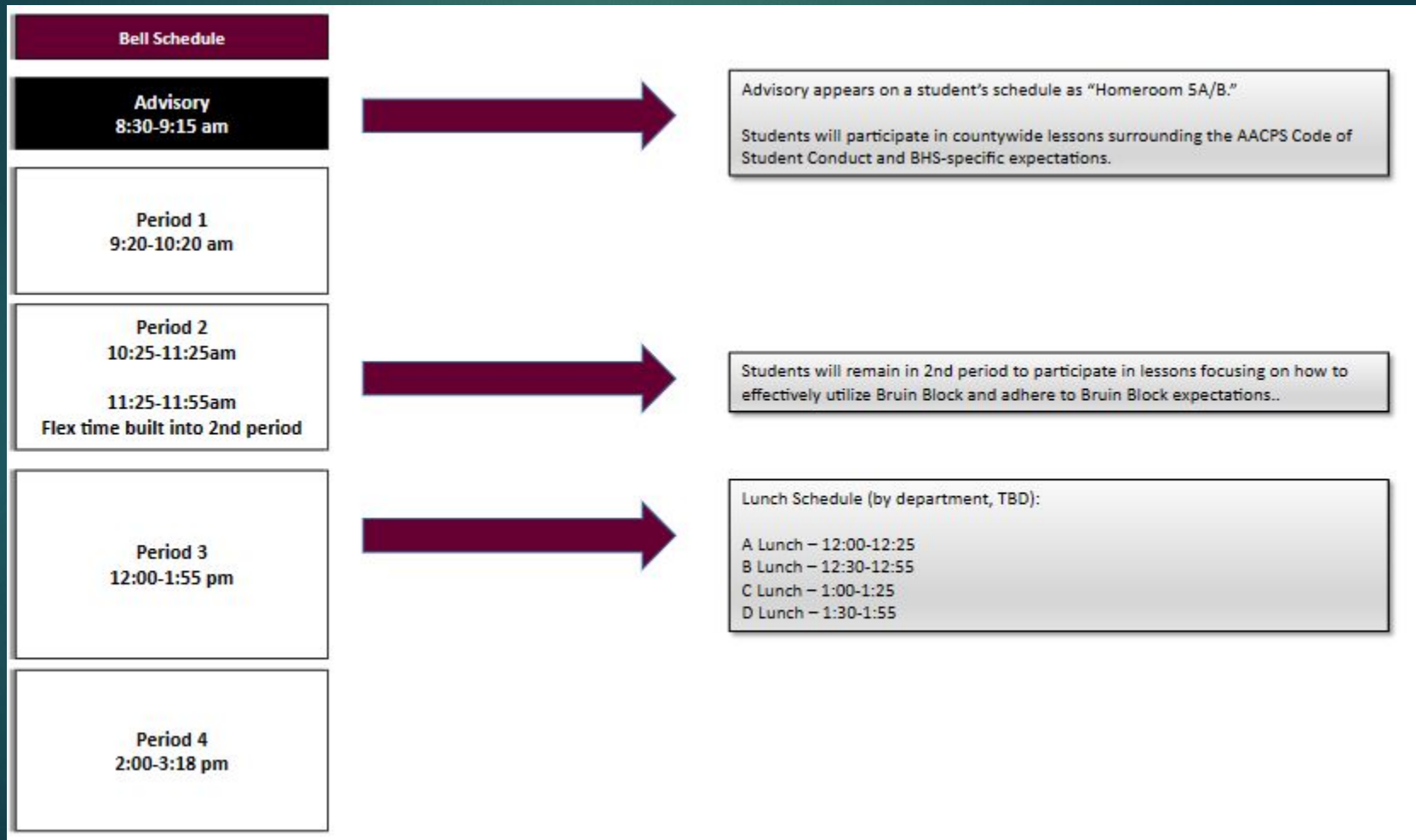
- ▶ 9th Grade Day is about FUN as a BRUIN!
