**School and Community:** Broadneck High School is one of twelve high schools in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. It is located just north of Annapolis and the U.S. Naval Academy, within thirty miles of Baltimore, Maryland, and Washington, D.C. The students live in suburban residential neighborhoods beside and around the Chesapeake Bay. Broadneck High School is a four-year comprehensive high school with an enrollment of approximately 2208 including a senior class of 533. In addition to our rigorous academics and full range of extracurricular activities, BHS has an Environmental Literacy Signature Program and is host to the AACPS High School Performing and Visual Arts (Music) Magnet Program, attracting talented students from beyond our attendance area.

**Our Program:** All seniors are required to earn 26 credits for graduation. These requirements include 4 credits of English, 3 credits of social studies (1 in Government, 1 in World Civilizations, and 1 in US History), 4 credits of math, 3 credits of lab science, 1 credit of PE, .5 credit of Health, 1 credit of fine arts, 1 credit of basic technology, and 8.5 elective credits.

Broadneck High School operates on a 4-period, A Day-B Day block schedule. Students have an opportunity to earn 8 credits during the school year.

**Class Rank:** Class Rank is determined at the end of the sixth semester (end of junior year). A final class rank is determined at the end of the senior year. All students are included in the ranking, which is based on all subjects. The rank is cumulative for the four-year period of grades 9-12. At the end of the junior year, the upper half of the **Class of 2022** had a weighted GPA of 3.55 or better. The upper 20% had a weighted GPA of 4.19 or better. Students with the same GPA are assigned the same rank.
